- 1. Attend Team Mom Meeting & get info about:
  - Team Roster/Team Name/Uniform
  - Volunteering in the Concession stand/Fundraising
  - Scorekeeping /Picture day /Team Trophies
  - Game day snacks/Sta Mo Snack Packs
  - Opening Day/Closing Day

## 2. Group Me

- Make sure to get with your coaches when parents ask questions so that you can answer do not wait for someone else to answer
- © Once you have your roster, please make sure that you check that all kids are coming to practice.
- If they are not, please reach out via another method just in case individuals do not have the GroupMe app yet.
- 3. Be sure that you know the website & point parents to it for information,
  - Website (www.stamoponybaseball.com)
- 4. At first practice discuss the following:
  - Ask anyone if they have experience or interest in scorekeeping
  - Ask anyone if they would like to be a co team mom so you are not alone if you are the only one
  - Intro yourself to the parents so they know who you are
  - Collect any misc. info (i.e. birthdays, allergies, etc.)
- 5. Put schedules together
  - Snack schedule /Concession stand duty
  - Scorekeeping
- 6. Other Items to Think About
  - Custom Parent shirts if you do not have someone you can contact Khris or Kecia
